After receiving her Woofi, a 98 year-old woman was smiling and crying and said to Woofi "I Love You" and then took off in her wheel chair to show everyone who

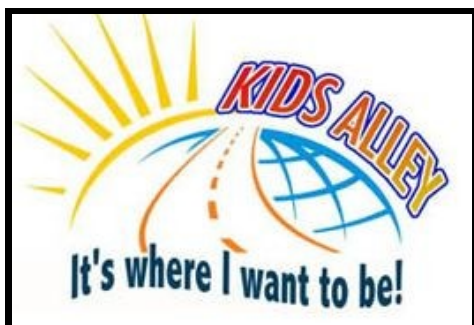
lived in her wing. And finally a 94 year-old woman did not recognize Carl until he gave her Woofi, "The church has not forgotten me!" she exclaimed.

## Woofi and Trinity Youth Support “Kid’s Alley”



“Kid’s Alley” ([www.kidsalley.org](http://www.kidsalley.org)) is an organization in the Camden area that reaches out to inner-city kids and their families with weekly programs and the goal of just sharing God’s love.

The Woofi team and a group of teens from the Trinity E. C. Church (Boyertown) youth group went to “Kid’s Alley” in South Jersey. Over the course of several Saturdays within the last year, we told the story of Woofi, handed out puppies and books, put on puppet shows, played games, did crafts and taught Bible lessons.

Our goal was to spend time with the kids and to teach them about how important it is to have Jesus in your daily life. Kid’s Alley is led by an amazing group of adult leaders who give so much of themselves to support these kids and their families—the dedicated staff and volunteers of Kid’s Alley are truly a blessing from God.

Woofi Ministries and the Trinity Youth were so grateful for this opportunity to love on these kids at Kid’s Alley. They continue to be in our prayers.

### “Week of Hope” continued

On Wednesday, a young girl from the area promised to return on the next day. On Thursday, the girl came as promised but not until 7:15. Normally the team would be packing up to return to their base camp at this time. But the leaders, Jonathan Knier and Mrs. Kriczky felt a tug from God to stay longer tonight.—something wonderful was going to happen.

The playground was next to a sports field and beyond that was some woods. Around 7:30, about ten children, ages 9 and under, came running out of the field and across the grass to the playground. They wanted to be with the Week of Hope kids and learn about Woofi.

After some sharing time about Woofi, Mrs. Kriczky wanted to give a Woofi to each child but there was not enough. She tried

to group the children by family and counted that ten Woofis would still be needed—but they only had eight! Another Trinity youth, Emily, went back to the vehicle to look for more. Mrs. Kriczky was sure that she grabbed all the Woofis earlier. Emily found that the vehicle was unlocked (although it had been locked previously) and then found two more Woofi puppies in the van. That meant there was ten! Exactly what was needed!

Emily went back to the group and all ten Woofi puppies were given to the children.

Just then a quick-moving thunderstorm appeared and everyone had to scatter. The children from the field returned as quickly as they came but what a success the evening was—God delivered!

- School / pre-schools



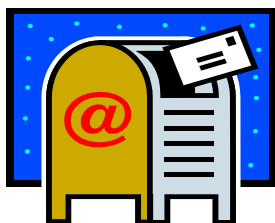
